**Is your program engaged in noteworthy and innovative practices relating to teaching and/or assessing specific competencies incorporated in the 5<sup>th</sup> edition of the professional competencies, or related to the six post-professional competencies?**

If so, consider submitting a descriptive proposal of your practice to be considered for presentation at our session at the NATA Annual Meeting. This session is jointly sponsored by the Executive Committee for Education and the Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (CAATE).

This fast-moving session will showcase best practices specific to instruction and/or assessment of competencies (or clusters of competencies) identified in the *NATA Education Competencies, 5<sup>th</sup> edition*, or within the 6 NATA post-professional competencies. We are seeking proposals for brief (8 – 10 minute) presentations that describe unique, contemporary strategies for competency instruction and assessment. Particular consideration will be given to those innovative practices relating to professional competencies that are new or significantly revised within the 5<sup>th</sup> edition, and to those incorporating the new NATA competencies within postprofessional education. This session will be similar in format to the highly-acclaimed pre-conference session at the 2011 Educators' Conference.

- Deadline for submission: March 1, 2012 by midnight.
- Submissions will be de-identified for the peer-review selection process.
- Presenters will be notified by April 1, 2012.
- Presentations will occur in St. Louis at the National Athletic Trainers' Association Annual Symposium on Thursday, June 28, 2012 from 7:00 am – 9:00 am
- Presenters are responsible for all expenses relating to attendance at the 2012 conference.
- Posters that are accepted for presentation at this conference are not eligible for presentation in this session
