The NATA Committee on Professional Ethics (COPE) of the National Athletic Trainers' Association (NATA) has issued Public Censures of the following member:

Mr. Darryl Turner has received a suspension of his NATA membership for one (1) year from February 26, 2019 through February 25, 2020, and a Public Censure for the following violations of the NATA Code of Ethics:

- 2.1. Members shall comply with applicable local, state, and federal laws, and any state athletic training practice acts.
- 2.2. Members shall understand and uphold all NATA Standards and the Code of Ethics.
- 2.3. Members shall refrain from, and report illegal or unethical practices related to athletic training.
- 3.5. Members shall educate those whom they supervise in the practice of athletic training about the Code of Ethics and stress the importance of adherence.
- 4.1 Members should conduct themselves personally and professionally in a manner that does not compromise their professional responsibilities or the practice of athletic training.
