The NATA Committee on Professional Ethics (COPE) of the National Athletic Trainers' Association (NATA) has issued Public Censures of the following member:

**Mr. Darryl Turner has received a suspension of his NATA membership for one (1) year from February 26, 2019 through February 25, 2020, and a Public Censure for the following violations of the NATA Code of Ethics:**

2.1. Members shall comply with applicable local, state, and federal laws, and any state athletic training practice acts.

2.2. Members shall understand and uphold all NATA Standards and the Code of Ethics.

2.3. Members shall refrain from, and report illegal or unethical practices related to athletic training.

3.5. Members shall educate those whom they supervise in the practice of athletic training about the Code of Ethics and stress the importance of adherence.

4.1 Members should conduct themselves personally and professionally in a manner that does not compromise their professional responsibilities or the practice of athletic training.
